ORGANIC: MORE THAN JUST A WORD

All substances used in organic agriculture & processing have been approved through a rigorous evidence-based process to minimize impact on human health and the environment.

Instead of relying on synthetic pesticides and fertilizers, organic producers must manage soil content, nutrients, fertility and pests in ways that do not contaminate crops and water with harmful or toxic substances. As set out in the Canadian Organic Standards, farmers promote soil fertility through crop rotation and the addition of organic matter and amendments to soil, rather than through synthetic fertilizers.

Any substance used in organic agriculture must meet the requirements of the permitted substances list of the Canada Organic Standards, and has gone through rigorous review to ensure its safety. Organics' no synthetics policy comes from a broader movement toward ecologically sustainable farming practices that benefit us and the land we live and grow on. When you choose organic, you are working toward a more sustainable future.

Organic means:

- **The use of GE seeds or substances is not permitted**
- **Soil health is improved through crop rotation and organic matter inputs**
- **Humane treatment practices encourage animal health**
- **A lower energy footprint because synthetic fertilizers aren't used**
- **No synthetic pesticides**
